requirements for an internship abroad	According to Article 37(4) of the Study and Examination Regulations of the University of Chemical Technology in Prague, an integral part of the study obligations is the completion of a study stay at a foreign institution of at least one month, while this requirement can also be fulfilled by a series of shorter professional stays, the duration of which is cumulative. This study requirement may also be fulfilled by direct participation in an international project or by working in an international research group, provided that the results are published in an international journal or otherwise presented to the professional public abroad.
